#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSIONS:**

#### % of Marks:

A student shall be allowed to take admission in the Major Course of B.A. /B.Sc. /B.Com. if he/she/transgender has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.

Admission will be on merit and availability of seats, provided that for SC/ST Candidates, the minimum marks for eligibility will be as per rules of the state Government.

## Provided however that:

- A candidate shall be allowed to take up Sociology if he/she/transgender has passed in the previous qualifying examination of any stream.
- **ii)** A candidate shall be allowed to take up B.Com. if he/she/transgender has studied Science subjects along with Mathematics in the previous qualifying exams.
- iii) A candidate shall be allowed to take up Physics Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics and Chemistry along with Physics

- and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying exams.
- **iv)** A candidate shall be allowed to take up Chemistry Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics and Physics along with Chemistry and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying exams.
- v) A candidate shall be allowed to take up Botany/Zoology Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Biology at the qualifying exams.
- vi) A candidate shall be allowed to take up Economics Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics or Business Economics including Business Mathematics, and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying exams.
- vii) No student other than those of Science stream and Economics/Geography of Arts stream will be allowed to take Science subjects as Minor Subjects.
- viii) No student of Arts and Commerce stream other than those of Geography and Economics will be allowed to take Science subjects as Minor Subjects.
- **ix)** A candidate shall be allowed to take up Geography Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Geography with other subjects at the qualifying exams.
- **x)** A candidate pursuing Major in a subject will not be allowed to take up the same subject as Minor.
- **xi)** While taking Major and Minor subjects, availability of the said subjects in the

concerned Colleges will be taken into cognizance.

- **xii)** A candidate pursuing Major in Economics will be awarded:
- a) B.Sc. Major if he/she/transgender chooses Mathematics as Minor (A) Subject.
- b) B.A. Major if he/she/transgender chooses English / History as Minor (A) Subject.
- **xiii)** A candidate pursuing Major in Geography will be awarded:
- a) B.Sc. Major if he/she/transgender chooses Mathematics as Minor (A) Subject.
- b) B.A. Major if he/she/transgender chooses
   Economics / English / History as Minor (A)
   Subject.

**Reservation of Seats:** There will be reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/Differently Able Candidates as per Govt. Rules. For differently – able candidates minimum disability at least 40% will be considered.

#### **ATTENDANCE:**

No student shall be allowed to take the end semester written Examination if the student concerned has not attended minimum of 75% of the classes held in the course concerned and also in other curricular components.

## POST GRADUATION IN NEPALI

### **ACTIVITIES**

# NCC unit of the College has always been active and both boys and girls are faring well in all the training camps. The NCC unit also actively participates in the Independence Day and Republic Day parades at Kurseong, and other activities such as blood donation, tree plantation, AIDS awareness rally, slum clearance, disaster management & relief and other social schemes.
