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1. SURVEY PROCESS:

Student Satisfaction Survey is one of the mandatory matrices, precisely 2.7.1 Under Criterion II of Teaching – Learning and Evaluation in the AQAR of NAAC.

This survey includes majorly the questionnaire recommended by NAAC. The survey is conducted and reported by Internal Quality Assessment Cell (IQAC) with support of Heads of all the departments. All final year students during the academic year 2019 were given an invitation to participate in this online survey. Participation was voluntary, the survey was implemented online, and respondents were ensured confidentiality. The questioners were prepared in the form of Google form and circulated to all the departments and then to students through whatsapp and email.

2. QUESTIONNAIRE:

The IQAC of the College decided to conduct the Student Satisfaction Survey with the questionnaire provided by NAAC. Link to the google form is provided under:

Out of 262 final year students to whom invitations were sent 104 [39%] students responded.

3. EVALUATION OF RESULTS:


The received response was evaluated using the cumulative grade point average [CGPA] method. As prescribed by NAAC, each question has a multiple choice system with scores ranging from 0 to 4. For each response, the total score was added and the grade point calculated by dividing the cumulative score by the total number of respondents.

CGPA of less than 2.5 were taken as areas in which the college has to improve upon and accordingly the IQAC formulated recommendations and action plans to improve upon the areas of concern.

Results:


Out of the 264 students of the Final year students to whom the invitation to fill up the form for SSS were sent, 104 students responded. The distribution of participants across various Disciplines is given in the chart below. 84 students from B.A. responded while the number of respondents from BSc and BCom were 15 and 5 respectively.

What subject area are you currently pursuing? 104 responses



1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 104 responses




2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 104 responses




3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 104 responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?


7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.


8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.




10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.




11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you. 104 responses




12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges. 104 responses




14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.


15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.




16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities. 104 responses




18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.




19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?




20. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good. 104 responses
